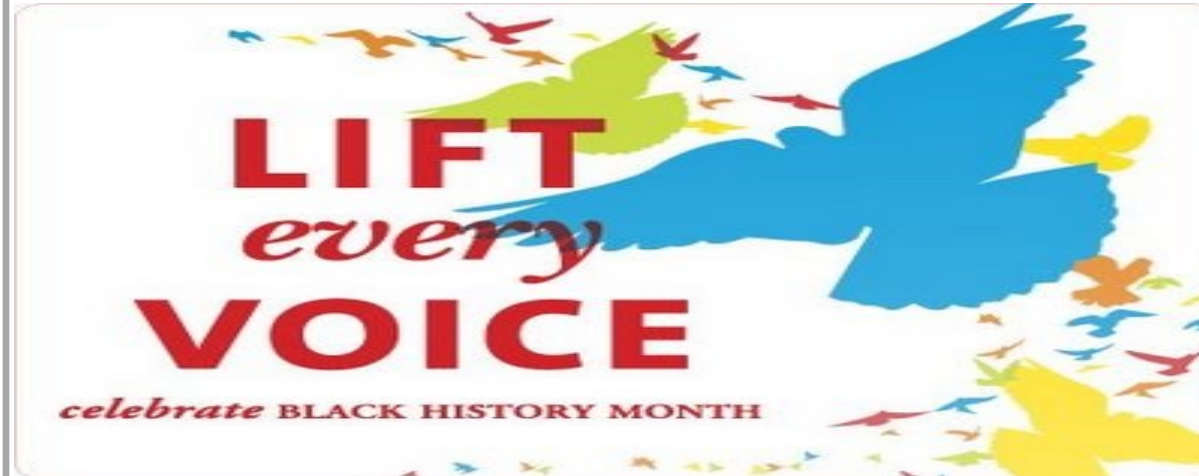
New giving app for iPhone users!
