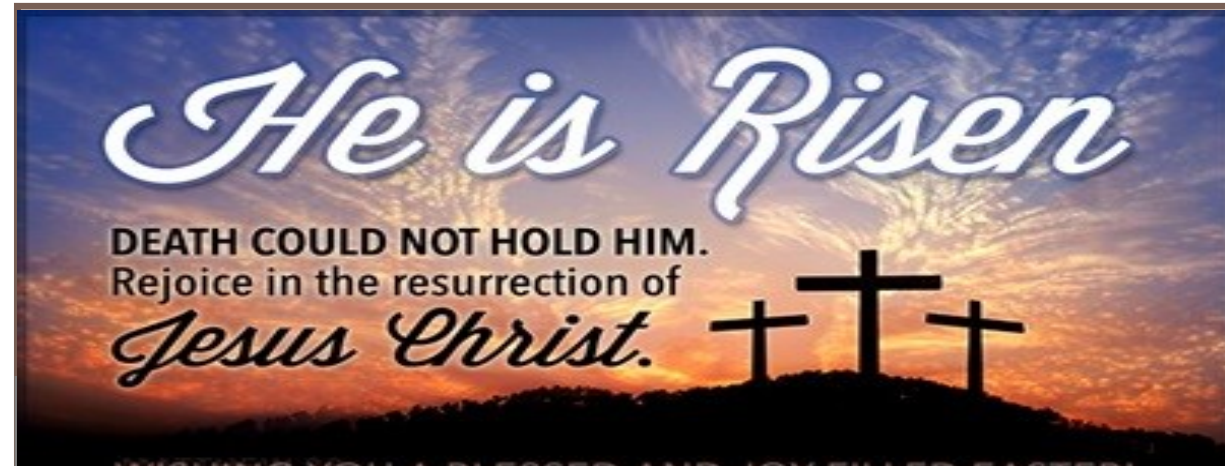
Kingdom Disciples: Heaven's Representatives on Earth
